

Nuova:

Middle-High School Writing Activity

Hive Mentality: Teaching collaboration and decision making.

Time: One class period

Materials: Chart Paper or Whiteboards

Listen to Nuova (from website) (9 minutes)

Have students write down anything they find interesting.

Try to get at least 5 things.

Have students pare their list to 5 and prioritize.

Break students into small groups (8 minutes)

Write all responses on a large surface.

Groups go through responses and prioritize their top 5 choices.

Pull class back together

Write all responses on large surface.

Let class choose their top 5 choices.

Note: Let students determine how they'll pick, usually ends up a vote.

Time permitting:

Discuss

Is this the best way to make all decisions? What are other ways people make decisions?

Should you listen to experts? Why?
