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Answer Sheet!

(1.) What liquid in the beehive becomes honey?

- Nectar

(2.) Where does the nectar come from?

- flowers

(3.) What do the bees use the honey for?

- for food, for themselves and their babies (larvae)

(4.) How do the students communicate with the bees to tell them about the big flower meadow?

- the bee dance

(5.) Why can't the bees collect nectar in the winter?

- Because all the flowers die.

(6.) Could bees collect all the nectar in one day to make enough honey to get them through the whole winter?

- With enough nectar rich flowers, and a strong hive, bees could make enough nectar in a week or two to last the winter.

(7.) Does the honey we buy at the store come from wild beehives?

- No, it comes from bee farms, tended by beekeepers.
