DOWNLOADING THE APP

- Open the app store on your device.
- Type "**Marine Debris Tracker**" into the search bar.
- Select and download the app that matches the picture on the right.
- Open the app.

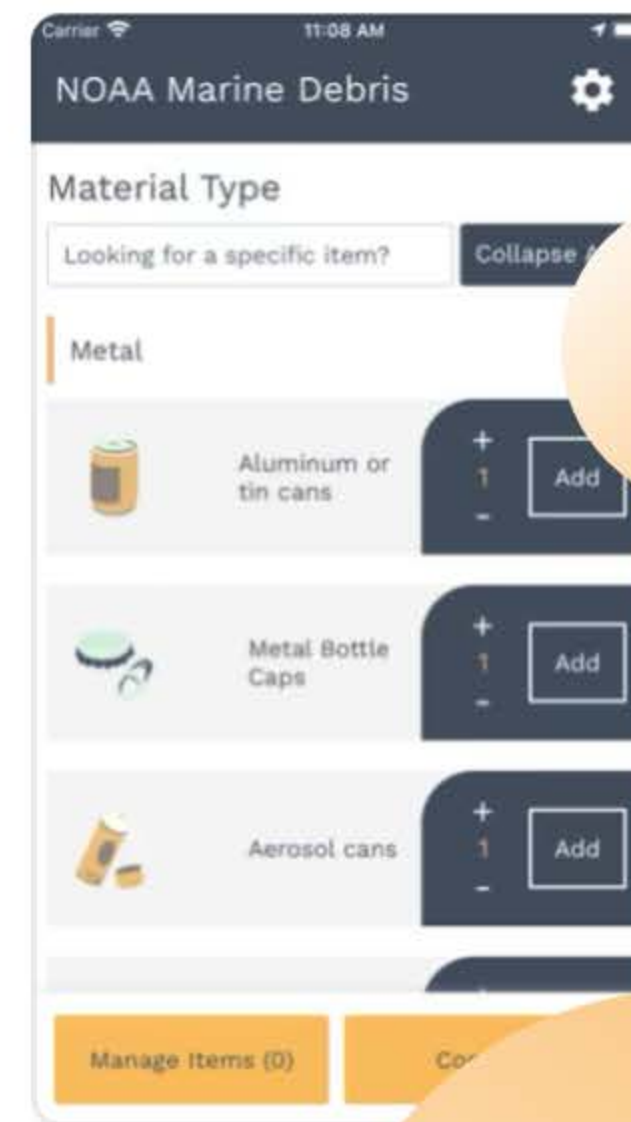
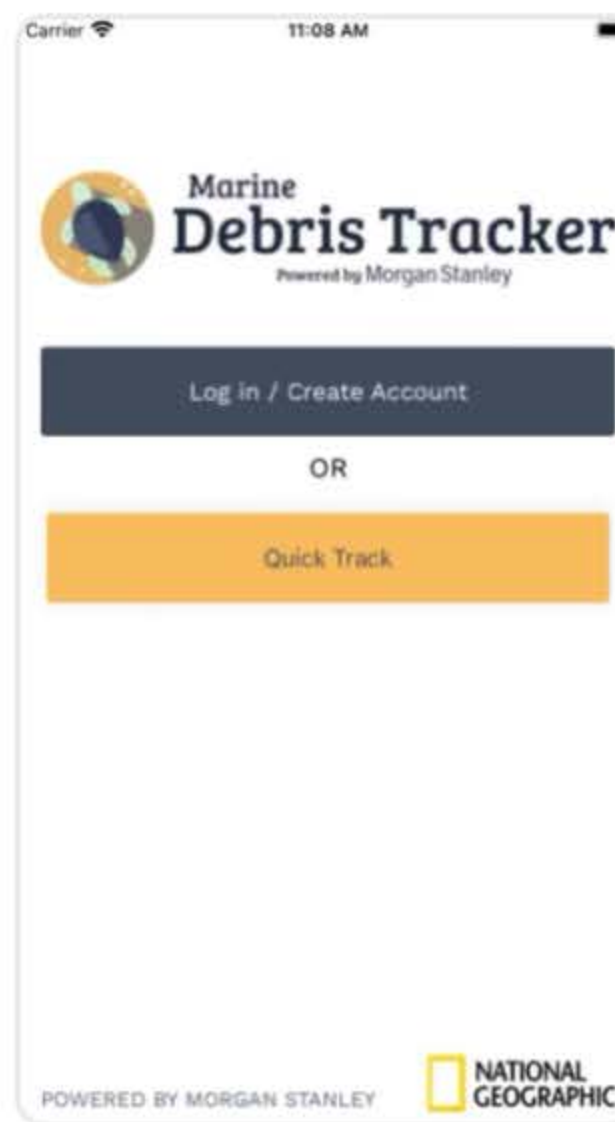

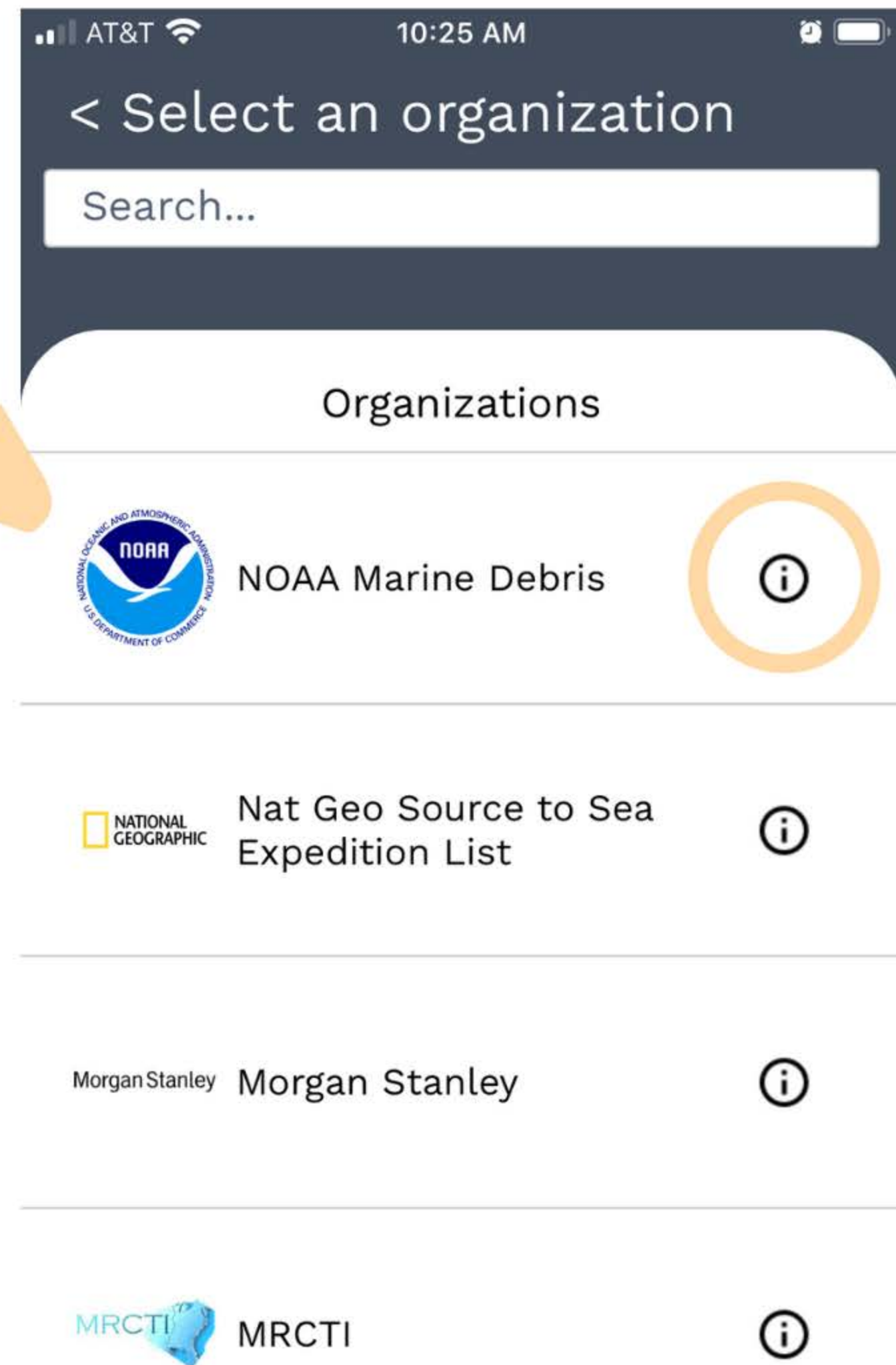
Quick Track

CREATING AN ACCOUNT:

- Your first prompt will be to either **Log in** or '**Quick Track**'. **Quick Track** will start a session for you, where you can begin tracking for the NOAA without signing up.
- To keep of your projects and data in the long term, select "**Log In / Create Account**".
- Enter your information where prompted.
- Once your account is created, you may use those credentials to access your cleanup logs from any device at any time at <http://marinedebris.engr.uga.edu>

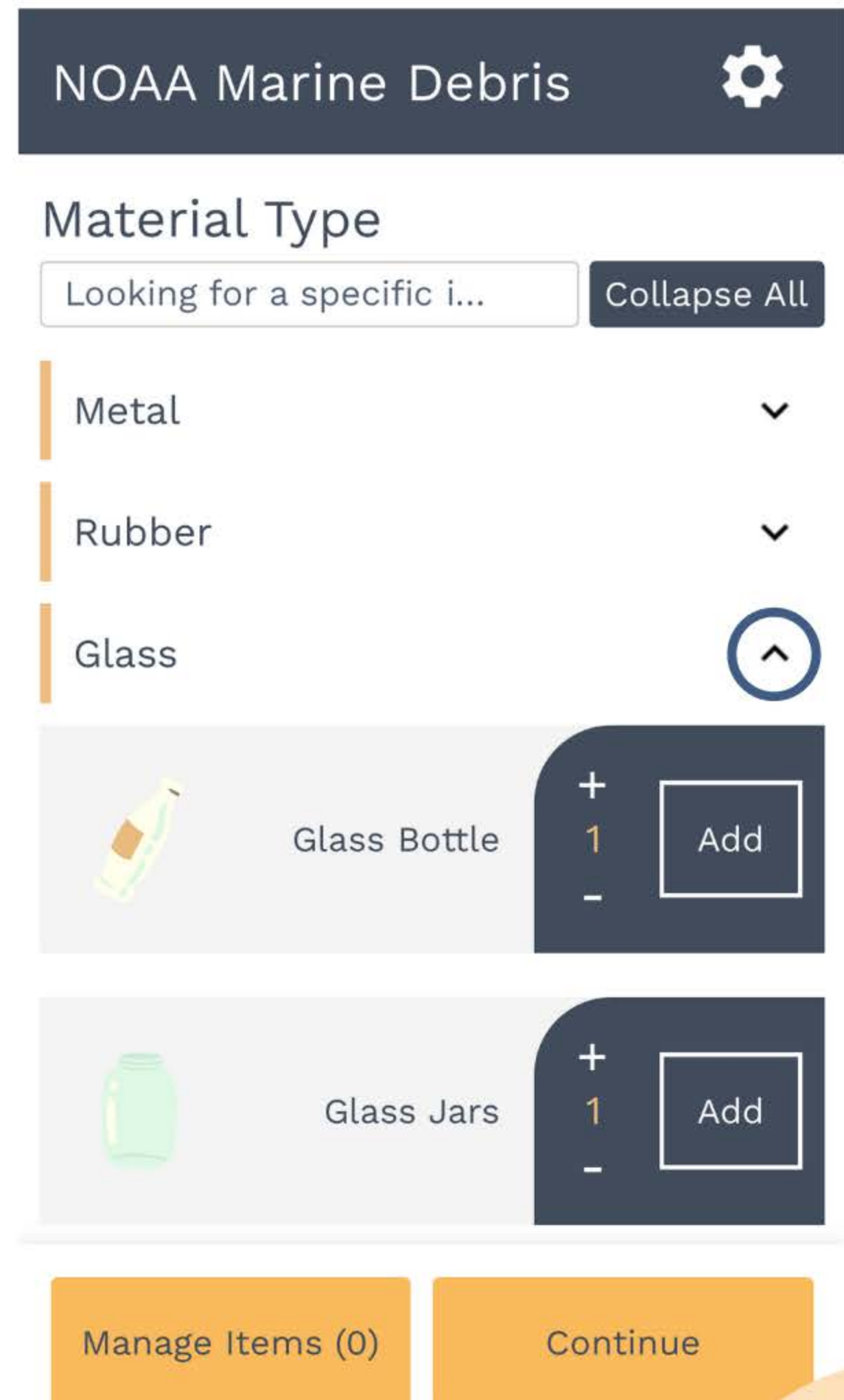
CHOOSE A LIST

- There are lists from over 25 organizations to be chosen from while you track your debris.
- It is recommended that you start with NOAA's (National Oceanographic and Atmospheric Administration) Marine Debris List.
- If you would like more information about a list, click the "i" button in the right hand corner of the lists icon.



TRACKING YOUR ITEMS

- Once you return to your collection home screen, you may begin logging items that you pick up.
- The collapsible orange menus represent sections of different types of debris. Clicking on them will bring you to a list of items that fall under those categories.
- For example, If you were to find a glass bottle, you would click on the “**Glass**” section and then scroll until you find the “**Glass Bottle**” item.

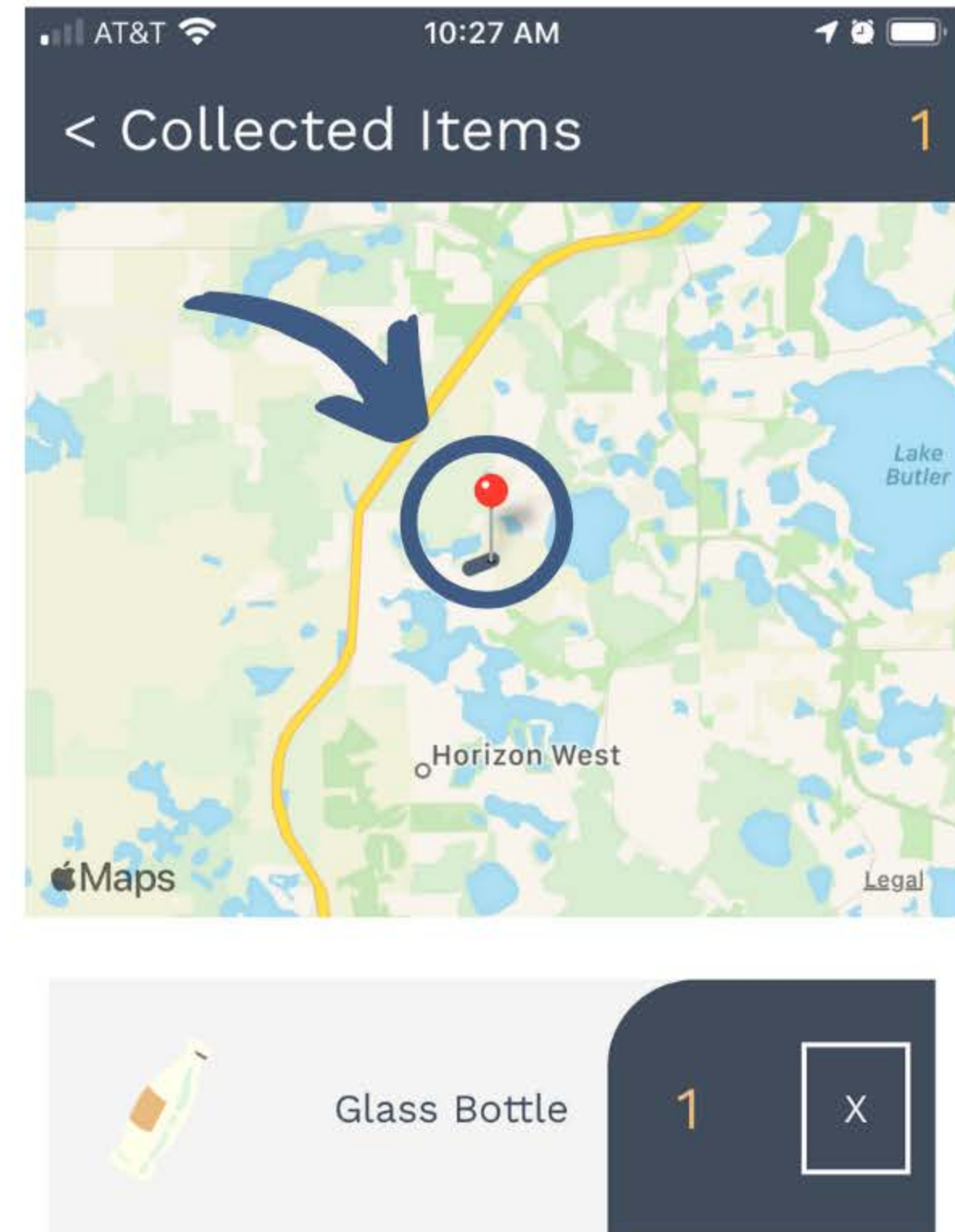

ADDING AN ITEM

- To add the paper bag to your collection, simply select the number of bags you found by either using the up/down arrows.
- Once you have the proper amount of items logged, you can press '**Add**'.
- When you add an item, the '**Manage Items**' button at the bottom of the screen should show your total number of logged items.

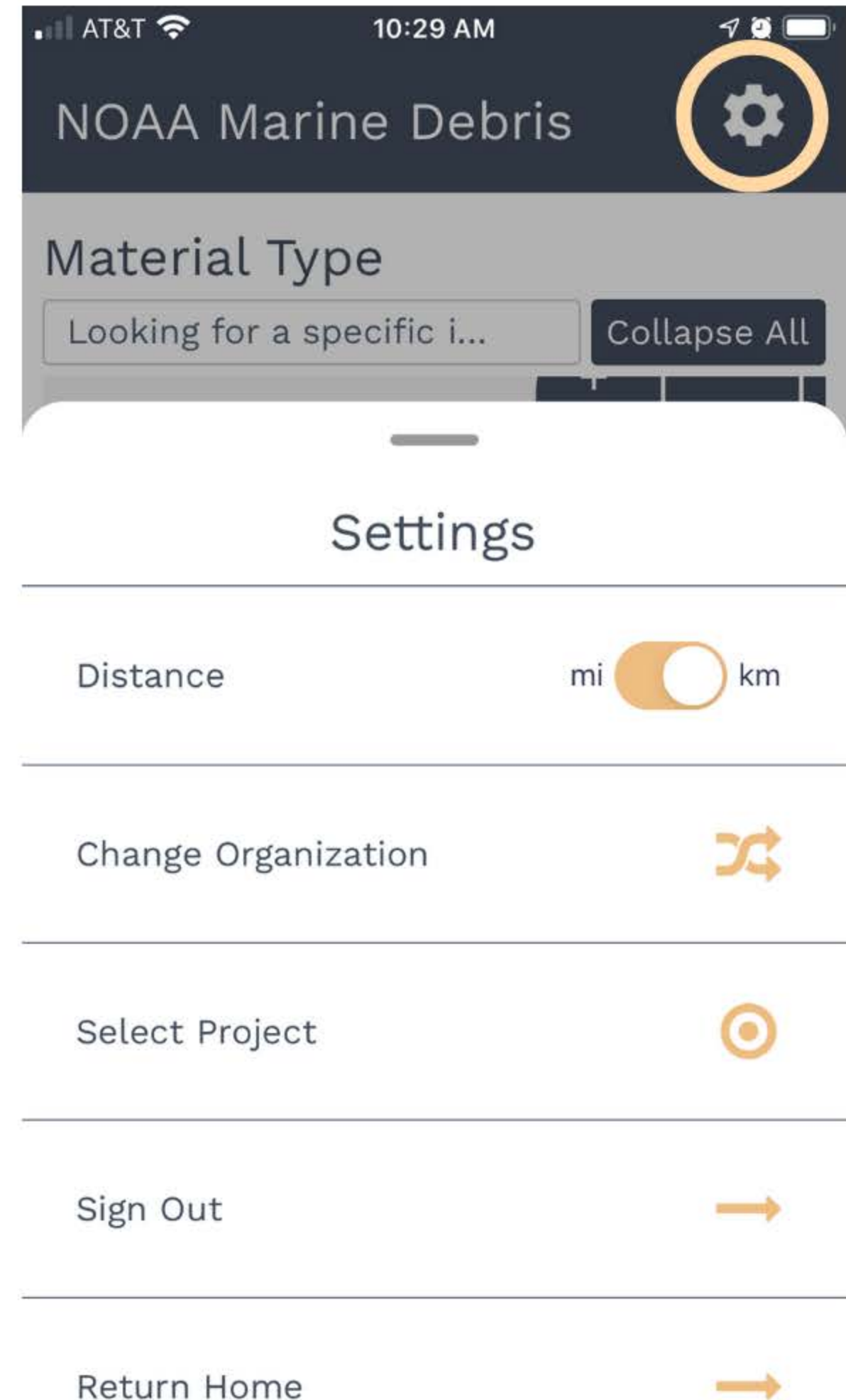
MANAGE ITEMS

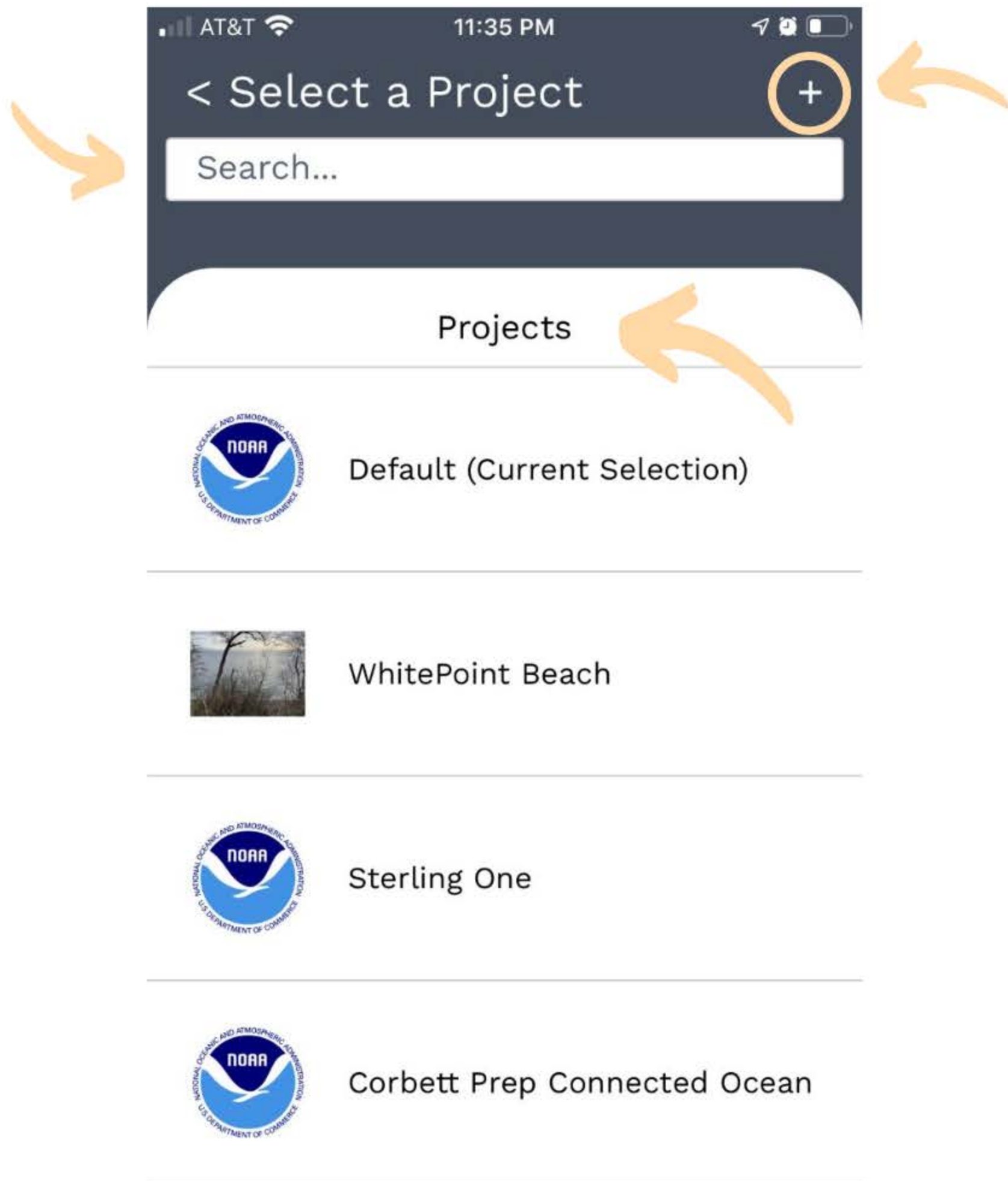
- Location tracking starts automatically when you log your first item.
- This feature allows the app to track where you are going throughout your cleanup in order to ensure the accuracy of the information being collected.
- To access this map, click '**Manage Items**' at the bottom of the collection screen.
- You may click the red location-markers to zoom in on the location.
- To remove a logged item, simply click the '**X**' button beside it on the list displayed below your map.



SETTINGS

- The **Settings** icon in the top right corner will bring up this menu.
- Here you can:
 - Change the measurement system the app uses to track your distance
 - Change the organization that will receive your tracking session
 - Attach your session to a project. These are ongoing studies or challenges by oceanic organizations that could use your data!
 - Sign out
 - Return to the Home screen



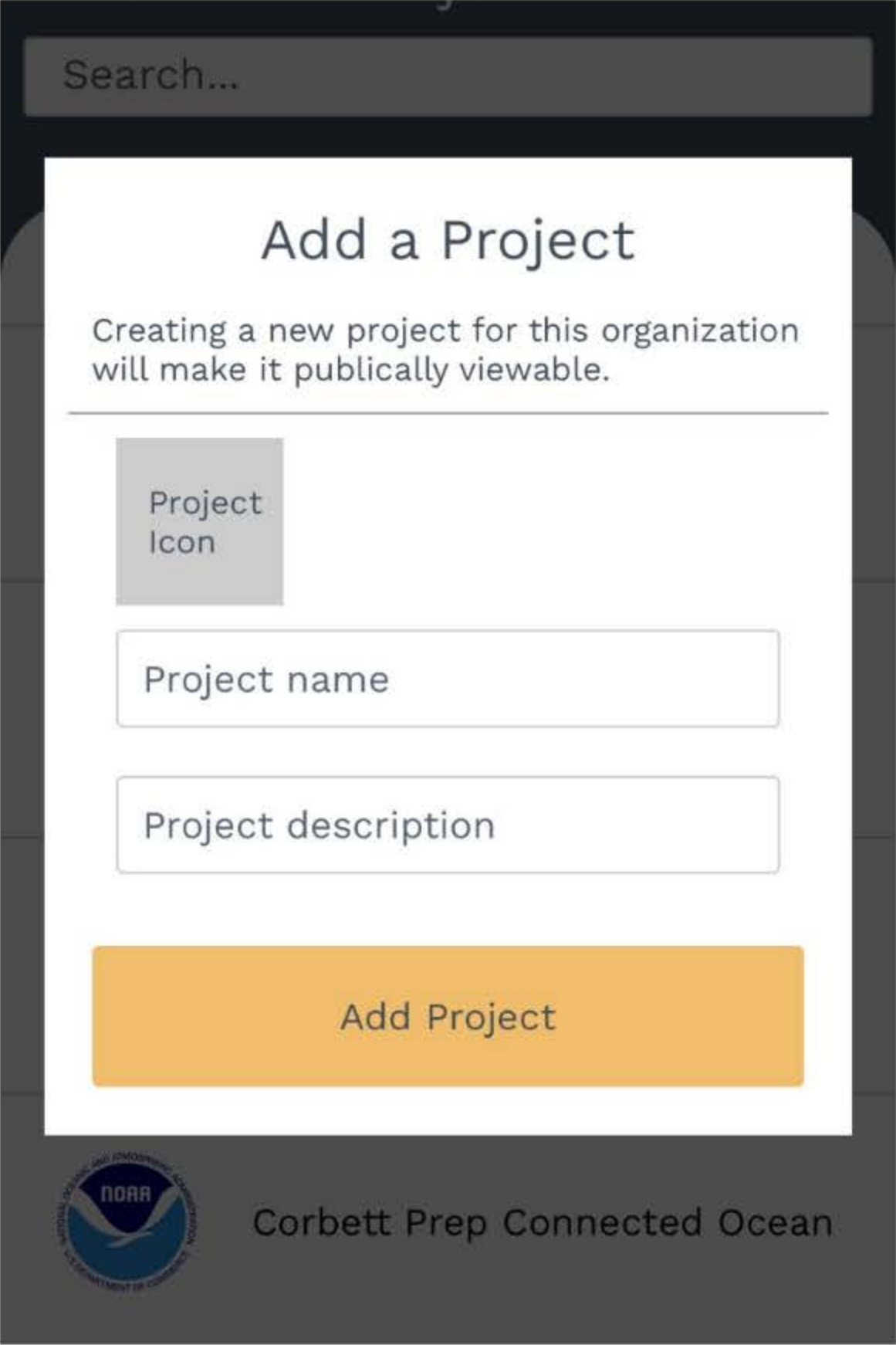


SELECTING A PROJECT

- To add your session to an organization's ongoing project, simply click '**Select A Project**' from the settings menu.
- You may choose any of the relevant projects from the resulting list.
- If you already know which project you'd like to submit to, search for it in the search bar at the top.
- You may also add your own project with the '+' icon in the top right corner.

ADD A PROJECT

- If you are adding your own project, you will see this screen.
- Here you can add a logo or icon, title and other relevant information for your project.
- Once entered, select '**Add Project**'.
- It will now appear on the list for others to add their sessions to.

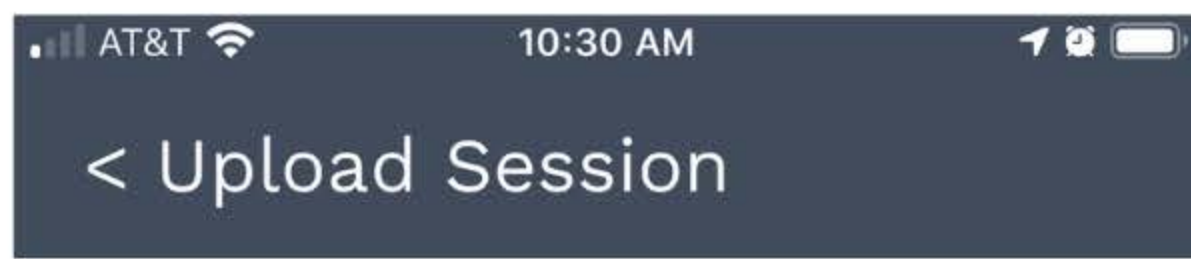

SUBMITTING A LOG

- Once you are done collecting items for your session, click on the '**Continue**' button at the bottom of the screen.
- You may add photos of your findings here with the '**Select Images**' icon.
- The chart in the center of the screen will show you how many items you logged, as well as the ratio of materials/types of objects collected.
- Once you've confirmed your log correctly reflects your collection session, you may press "**Upload Session**".
- If you do not have data or wifi available, you may press "**Upload Later**" and submit once you gain a connection by visiting "**Upload Saved Session**" on the home screen.

ACCESSING YOUR DEBRIS LOGGING DATA

You can access your debris logging data at any time by visiting the Marine Debris Tracker website at <https://debristracker.org/>. First, select 'Log In' in the top right corner.



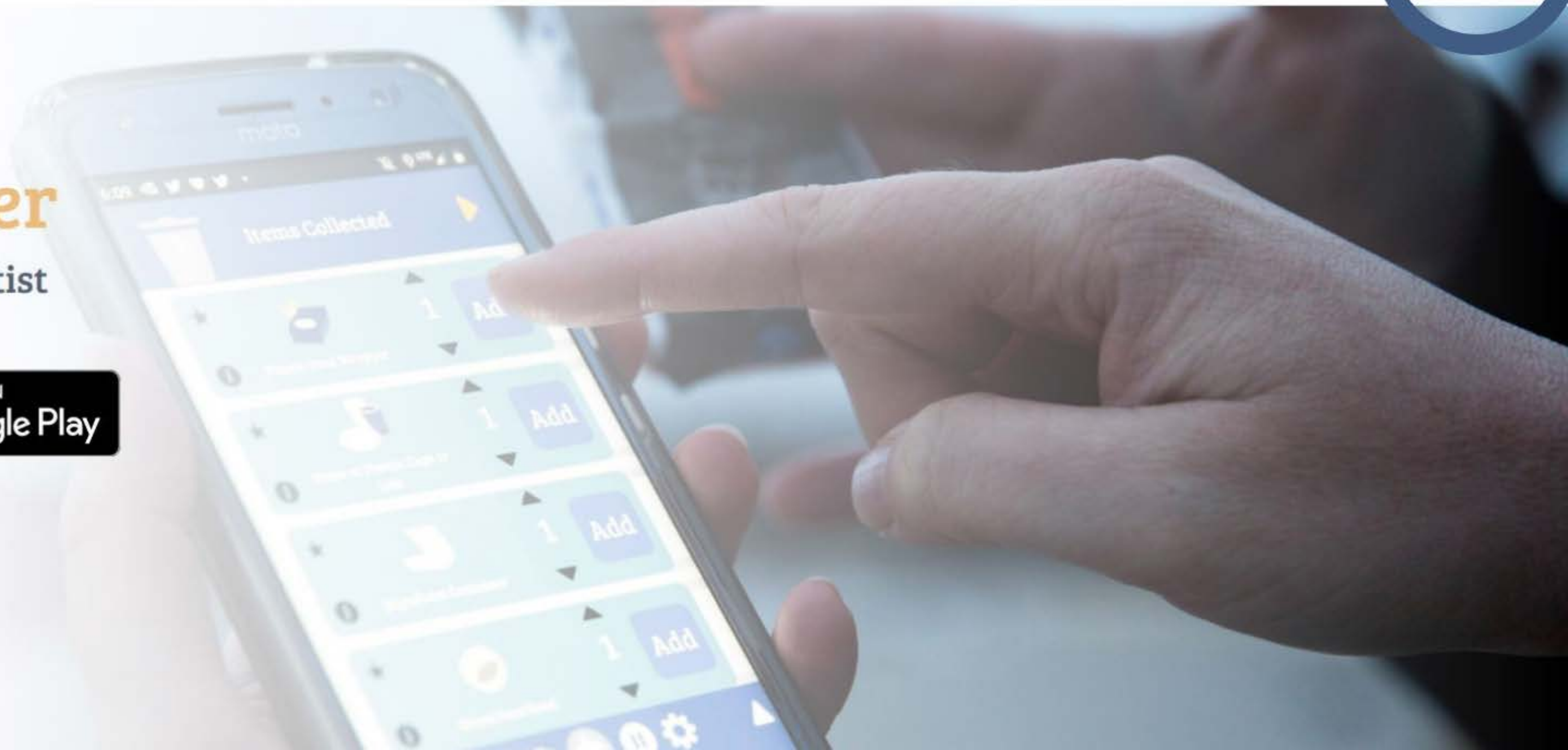
